In terms of Regulation 30 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with Para B of Part A of Schedule III to the said Regulations, we are pleased to inform that Company has emerged as the successful winner in Maharashtra State Electricity Distribution Company Limited (MSEDCL) tender for Selection of Solar Power Developer (SPD) for solar photovoltaic power generating stations of an aggregate capacity of 9 MW(AC) under Mukhyamantri Saur Krushi Vahini Yojana 2.0- a scheme launched for Implementation of feeder level solarisation under Component C of PM KUSUM Scheme. This is milestone achievement in our journey towards excellence growth.

The Company had participated in the Competitive bidding process vide RFS No.MSKVY-MSE-01, DATED 25-01-2024. And RFS by way of submission of documents along with Technical Bid (Envelope I) and Financial Bid (Envelope II) at MSEB Solar Agro Power Limited(MSAPL) office and online submissions on Bharat E-portal on 09-08-2024.

We have received the Letter of Award with reference no. CE/RE/MSKVY 2.0/ROUND4/LOA/31636 dated October 09, 2024, awarding us the 9 MW(AC) for Solar power Developer for solar photovoltaic power generating stations. The Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with MSEDCL shall be executed within a period of 15 (fifteen) days from the date of this LOA. The PPA shall be signed only upon receipt of the Performance Bank Guarantee with the validity period of 24 (twenty-four) months from date of issuance of this LOA.

The applicable tariff (3.08 tariff per unit) payable shall be fixed for 25 (twenty-five) years from the Scheduled Commercial Operation Date, as per Letter of Award. The project is expected to cumulative energy generation over period of 25 years is 4,51,687,500 units(approximately estimated amounting of Rs. 13,91,203,660)

Further, the details as required under Regulation 30 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Circular SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13,2023 are given in the enclosed Annexure A.
